ACTIVATE THE LASERS

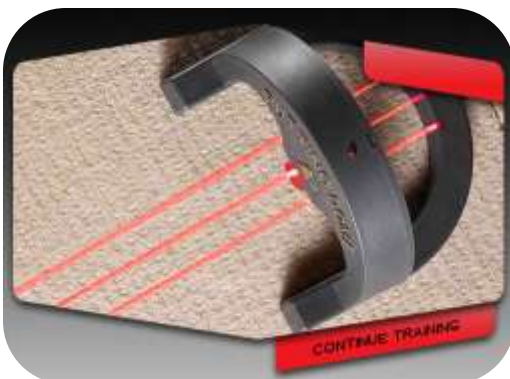
The Argon's lasers are turned on & off via two sensors located in the grip of the club. These sensors were designed to be located where your thumbs would rest naturally. The lasers are easily activated with a soft touch and can be kept on throughout the stroke. These sensors provide you with full control of the Argon's 3-laser-system. You can turn the lasers on & off on-demand.

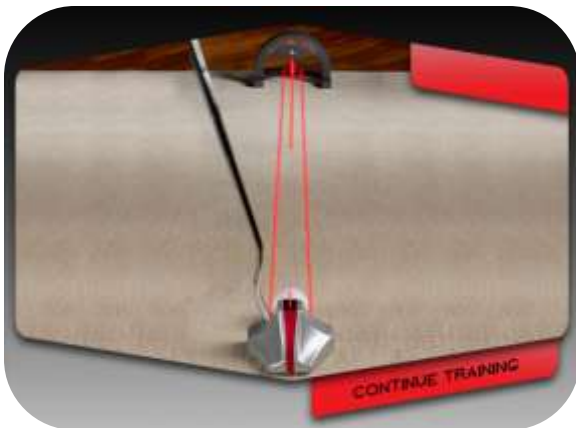
“PRONGED” 3-LASER-SYSTEM

When you activate the Argon's laser system, you'll see two lower lasers running parallel along the ground outlining the putting path of the ball. A third laser—located high & in the middle of the clubface— focuses its light on top of the golf ball, and simultaneously lights a straight line to the target.

With the Argon, you line up behind the ball in a putting position with the ability to instantly see both your alignment and where the clubface will impact the ball during your stroke.

FUNDAMENTAL #1: ALIGNMENT

1. Grip the club, noting the location of the 2 sensors.
2. With the lasers off, align yourself to the Putting Dome and prepare to putt.
3. Activate the 3-laser-system.

The two lower lasers run parallel outlining the putting path of the ball. If you are aligned perfectly, these two lasers will outline a straight path to the putting target.

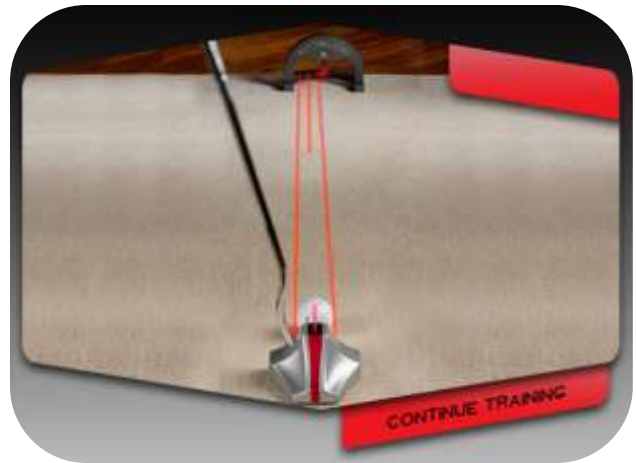
The upper laser moves over the ball and continues forward. If you are aligned perfectly, the upper laser will shine on the Putting Dome's red bull's-eye.

TRAINING TIP

If after activating the lasers, you see you are not aligned properly, examine your putting setup. Make sure the face of the putter is at the target. Do not simply turn the club head to align the putter and its lasers to the perfect putt position. Instead, observe how adjustments to your setup affect alignment. Step away, reset yourself to putt to the target, and activate the lasers again.

FUNDAMENTAL #2: STROKE

1. Align yourself.
2. Prepare to putt.
3. Activate the lasers.
4. Focus on the upper laser's beam.

The Argon's upper laser is on top of the ball and allows you to concentrate on the point of contact as you bring the putter back and then through the ball. Work on a stroke that allows you to hit the ball squarely in the center of the club face each time.

Focus on the upper laser's beam during your putt to understand the importance of a smooth back and forward stroke. When you feel like your stroke is addressing the ball squarely in center of the ball, putt without the lasers.
